

MGH VISITOR RESTRICTIONS

Starting July 6th, Marion General Hospital will begin relaxing some of the temporary visitor restrictions in place at the start of the COVID-19 pandemic.

For your safety, as well as the safety of patients and caregivers:

- Visitation is recommended between the hours of 8:00 am and 8:00 pm.
 - 8:00 am to 5:30 pm Entry at the Main Entrance
 - 5:30 pm to 8:00 pm Entry at the Emergency Department
- Face masks are required at all times during your visit to an MGH facility
- All visitors will be screened and given an identification badge to display on their upper chest. After being screened, inpatient visitors will be asked to go directly to the patient room. *Other parts of the hospital, including cafeterias and gift shops, are closed to visitors at this time.*
- 1 or 2 dedicated visitors per patient, depending on the unit, will be allowed.

The following patient care areas may receive limited dedicated visitor(s):

One (1) Visitor is permitted to accompany an ED patient

One (1) Visitor is permitted while a patient is being admitted to the Hospital

Two (2) Parents are permitted to accompany a Pediatric patient

Two (2) Parents are permitted to accompany a Special Care Nursery patient

Two (2) Visitors are permitted to accompany an Obstetrics patient

One (1) Visitor is permitted to ARU

One (1) Visitor is permitted to Critical Care (Non-Covid)

One (1) Visitor is permitted to Telemetry (Non-Covid)

One (1) Visitor to Medical Surgical

*****End of Life considerations will be made on a case by case basis*****

Marion General Hospital has taken additional steps to ensure safety for patients, visitors and team members at each location:

- **Masks:** Providers and patient-facing team members always wear masks at every MGH facility where patient care is provided. Patients and visitors will also be required to wear masks.
- **Social distancing:** MGH supports social distancing guidelines by redesigning spaces and displaying six-foot distances wherever possible.
- **Limited waiting room time:** MGH is working to decrease (or even eliminate) the time patients spend in waiting rooms.
- **Continual disinfecting:** MGH has enhanced disinfecting procedures to ensure spaces and surfaces remain thoroughly clean throughout the day.
