AMOUNT GENERALLY BILLED CALCULATION

Effective July 1, 2020

Amount Generally Billed (AGB) - Following a determination of financial assistance, an individual eligible for financial assistance will not be billed more for emergency or other medically necessary care than the amounts generally billed (AGB) to individuals who have insurance covering such care. MGH will calculate the AGB annually using the “look-back method” based on actual claims paid to MGH from Medicare fee-for service together with all private health insurers paying claims to the hospital (including, in each case, any associated portion of these claims paid by Medicare beneficiaries or insured individuals). MGH will begin applying its AGB percentages by the 120th day after the end of the 12-month period used in calculating the AGB percentage.
